For Board Education, Director Harkness went over the various options for a new library, including the various funding sources from the state and what that would mean for local matches. The most economical option is a renovation of an existing building. The was much discussion, including the need to have the building be within the city limits so as to not lose City funding for the library.

Kim plans to go to the Board of Commissioners soon to discuss support and a replacement for Mr. Raulerson from the BOC.

The board elected to add an item to the agenda, with Haulk making the motion, Rembert second, and unanimous by Rembert, Haulk, Pond and Dennis.

The additional item was to bring to consideration for Debbie Forward as member to the board. Motion by Rembert, second by Dennis, and unanimous by Rembert, Haulk, Pond and Dennis.
