As libraries are considered public spaces, there is no expectation of privacy from photography or videography in open areas. Chattahoochee Valley Libraries (CVL) may reasonably restrict photography and recordings in its spaces, particularly for activities or behaviors which do not meet our Customer Code of Conduct, or would be disruptive or interfere with other customers and staff in the use of the facility.

CVL reserves the right to utilize photographs or video taken at the library for publicity purposes in printed materials and electronically. All customers consent to the use of their photo or video taken at the Libraries during public events, unless they specifically inform staff of an objection to such use. No identifying information will be utilized in conjunction with the photos or video without the consent of the person, or their responsible caregiver.

Those who wish to use library spaces for photography/recordings beyond reasonable use must secure prior permission from the Library Director or their designee.
